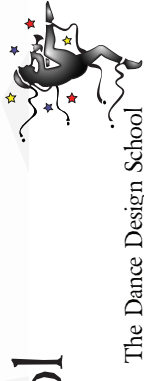

Dance Department Policy Statement

The Dance Design School
Teaching the heart of dance

★ Students register for 33 classes during the 10 month school year. The Year End Show rehearsals count as 1 class. Please count the 33 classes on the calendar.

★ If you choose the Payment Plan, payments are due on the first (1st) of each of the 10 school months. Payments must be made with debit or credit card. A 4% late charge will be added to the unpaid balance for payments made after the 1st of the month. All accounts in arrears of 2 months or more will be subject to 10% interest charges, and students will not be allowed to attend class until the balance is paid. All bills that are sent to collection will have an added 33% to pay for collection charges.

★ Withdrawal Of Classes: If a student wishes to withdraw from the program, 30 days notice must be given with our 'Withdrawal Form'. Students/parents are responsible for tuition incurred until the end of payment cycle in which we receive a withdrawal form (available at the main office). After filling out our withdrawal form, charges will stop for the following month. No partial payments will be accepted. No refunds will be given for missed classes/lessons. There will be no accepted withdrawals after May 1. Re-registering students in the same school year must pay the \$45 registration fee in order to start classes again.

★ In case of the cancellation of classes due to bad weather, the Dance Design School will make every effort to provide the 33 classes upon which the tuition schedule is based. The Dance Design School, however, is not obliged to make up all or part of classes canceled due to bad weather. Students are encouraged to make up in comparable or lower level classes whenever possible. For class cancellations due to weather, check the web site, dancedesignschool.com or call the studio 534-9671.

★ If your child misses a class due to illness or school/family obligations, you may schedule a make up class in any class of a similar level. Please call the office to ensure the class is not full. There will be no individual make ups after May 1st.

5 Ways To Get The Most Out Of Your Music & Voice Lessons

1. How Young Is Too Young - Starting At The Right Age

When adults begin instrument lessons there are no concerns about focus or determination, but for children, starting at the right age is key to their successful learning. “The Sooner The Better” theory often backfires and can have a negative effect on the child. Children may become overwhelmed, frustrated and stop wanting to come for lessons. Starting at the right age will help ensure enjoyment, focus and a positive experience. The following are guidelines that will help you determine the optimal age for your child to start taking music lessons.

- Piano/Keyboard - We recommend beginning private lessons no earlier than age 5. Each child has a different focus and retention of material at this age, so speak with one of our teachers to help determine if your child is ready. Whenever your child decides to begin lessons, he/she will find the piano a fun and rewarding instrument.
- Guitar (Acoustic or Electric) - 8 years old is a good age to start guitar lessons, however it is never too late to begin this instrument. Playing the guitar takes strength in the fingertips in order to press the guitar strings hard enough to produce correct sound. Before the age of 8 children have small hands and may find playing the guitar uncomfortable or frustrating. We offer ukulele and violin lessons for children younger than age 8.
- Voice - 11 is the age voice experts suggest to begin private vocal coaching. Due to the physical nature of voice lessons (proper breathing techniques, development of the vocal chords and lung capacity), young children are not ready for the rigors of private vocal training.
- Younger Musicians - Starting music at a young age is shown to boost brain development and language skills. We offer a variety of group music lessons for students who are not yet ready for private lessons. For ages 0-3, we offer a Music Pups class which teaches rhythms, diverse song styles and an introduction to instruments. For ages 4-6, we offer a Music Adventures class which will teach the basics of piano. This class teaches kids to read music, rhythms, and piano playing, using fun kid games.

2. Group Classes vs. Private Lessons

When signing up for music or voice lessons, choosing the correct class format can make the difference between success and failure. Group classes work well for chorus singing, music theory, band or orchestra. Working as a group is a unique musical skill that can only be taught in a group class setting. However, when learning a specific instrument or teaching voice, private lessons allow for the greatest success in the quickest time.

3. Class Location

Children learn music best when the learning location is free of distractions. In a music school environment a student cannot be distracted by television, pets, ringing phones, siblings or the rhythms of home life. A half hour of lesson time per week at a professional music school location can produce better results than an ‘at home lesson’, since the only focus during lesson time is learning music.

4. Make Practicing Easier

As with anything, practice makes perfect. Difficulties between parents and music students can arise when there is not a system set up at home for practicing. Here are some ways to make practicing fun and stress free:

- Time - Set the same time everyday to practice, so it becomes part of your child’s daily routine.
- Repetition - For children 20-30 minutes can seem like eternity. Instead of setting a time frame, try asking your child to repeat their music piece 4 times or their scales 5 times. To a child, this gives a more manageable practice goal.
- Rewards - To make practice fun for your child, you may find encouragement, such as praise, stickers or small rewards like hot chocolate or a hug, can go a long way.

5. Use Recognized Teaching Materials With a Trained Professional

Our University trained teachers use excellent teaching books to help you or your child learn with the best possible results. Our teachers will guide you to a music book that will be appropriate for your level and learning style. For example, a 5 year old beginner piano student would learn differently than a beginner adult or experienced teenager. A teenage vocal student will enjoy different music styles than an adult. These books ensure that no important part of learning is inadvertently left out. Our library has been researched and is continually upgraded to make learning easier.

Have Fun! Giving the gift of music will last a lifetime. Remember the important part of music lessons is to enjoy the journey.

Music Department Policy Statement



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★ Students register for 33 lessons during the 10 month school year. Recital rehearsals count as 1 class. Please count the 33 classes on the calendar.

★ If you chose the Payment Plan, payments are due on the first (1st) of each of the 10 school months (September 1-June 1) or the fifteenth (15th) or the month prior (August 15-May 15). Payments may be made via automatic debit or credit card billing. A 5% late charge will be added to the unpaid balance for payment made after the 1st of the month. All accounts in arrears of 2 months or more will be subject to 10% interest charges, and students will not be allowed to attend class until the balance is paid. All bills that are sent to collection will have an added 33% to pay for collection and attorney fees.

★ Withdrawal: If a student wishes to withdraw from the program notice must be given 30 days prior to stopping lessons and a Withdrawal Form (available at the main office) must be filled out. There will be no accepted withdrawals after May 1. No partial payments will be accepted. No refunds will be given for missed classes/lessons. Re-registering students in the same school year must pay the \$45 registration fee in order to start classes again.

★ In case of the cancellation of classes due to bad weather, the Dance Design School will make every effort to provide the 33 classes upon which the tuition schedule is based. The Dance Design School, however, is not obliged to make up all or part of classes canceled due to bad weather. For class cancellations due to weather, check the web site, dancedesignschool.com or call the studio 534-9671.

★ Students who miss a lesson due to illness are eligible to take our group make-up music theory lesson. In order to secure a spot in the group make-up lesson, the parent must call 24 hours in advance to cancel the lesson. Group make-up lessons are offered once per month, an email notification of the day and time will be sent prior to the class. A maximum of 1 missed lesson per month is eligible for the group make up. Dance Design School is not required to hold make-up lessons, however, every attempt to schedule a group make-up lesson will be made. The full monthly payment is required even if a lesson is missed.
