## Dance & Music Design School ~ Scholarship Opportunities

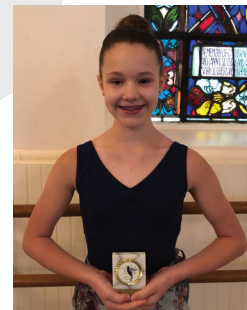
