

The Mel Johnson Ballet Scholarship For the promising male dancer.

Mel Johnson was born in Cornwall NY and began dancing at age 12. He went on to dance with State Ballet of Rhode Island, New Haven Ballet, Miami Ballet, and Joffrey ballet. Mr. Johnson was the director of the Fort Walton Beach Ballet Association. When Mr. Johnson wasn't dancing, he was a decorated Vietnam veteran and an archivist at Washington's Headquarters.

Mr. Johnson was well known for his portrayal of Herr. Drosselmeyer in the HVDT's 'Nutcracker Short & Sweet'. He taught Men's Class and was a guest teacher at D&MDS for many years. Mr. Johnson loved encouraging the next generation of dancer.

The M.J. Scholarship will be awarded to one male ballet dancer and cover the cost of one ballet class per week for the duration of the 2019-2020 school year.

Eligibility:

- *Applicant may be any age at the time of the audition.
- *Applicant may not miss any class except in the case of illness. All missed classes must be made up with an additional class. Any missed classes that are not made up within 1 month will cause the loss of scholarship money.
